MAIN OBJECTIVE

Improvement of the quality of emergency medical care by investing in human capital, with a special focus on vulnerable population groups, through increasing the knowledge and skills of the emergency medical care system staff.

START DATE: 10.07.2009

END DATE: 10.03.2015

BUDGET: BGN 3 730 669,37





In the implementation of project BG051RO001-6.02.02 **"PRACTICAL INTRODUCTION TO THE TREATMENT OF EMERGENCY CONDITIONS"**, funded under the Operational Program "Human Resources Development" 2007-2013, more than 6 000 specialists were trained - doctors, medical specialists and drivers from the Emergency Medical Care Centers, as well as doctors and medical specialists from 33 hospitals, with emergency departments. Specialized equipment was purchased to provide advanced training, incl. various types of medical dummies, defibrillators and respiratory tract kits for adults and children.

- Performed training of:
 - **5 580 EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE CENTER STAFF** (doctors, medical specialists and drivers)
 - **462 EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT STAFF** (doctors and medical specialists) from 33 hospitals
- Specialized medical equipment purchased for the needs of training.

The current Project BG05M9OP001-3.007-0001 **“IMPROVING CONDITIONS FOR TREATMENT OF EMERGENCY”**, funded under the Operational Program "Human Resources Development" 2014-2020 implemented by the Ministry of Health, provides for continuation and upgrading of the achieved results.

OBJECTIVES :

The main objective of the project is to improve the quality of the emergency medical care provided by investing in human capital. The specific objective is to improve the knowledge and skills of emergency medical staff by continuing education. A National Center for Training and Qualification in the Emergency Medical Assistance System will be constructed and equipped in the implementation of the project.

START DATE: 28.02.2017

END DATE: 31.12.2019

BUDGET: BGN 7 000 000





ACTIVITIES :

- Establishment of a National Center for Continuing Education of the Employees in the Emergency Medical Care System.
- Perform analyzes of the need for training.
- Establishment of methodology and programs for initial, periodic and ongoing training of all categories of staff from the emergency medical care and emergency departments of the hospitals.
- Development and introduction of methodologies for periodic assessment of the qualification and professional skills in emergency medical care.
- Conducting trainings of **6 892 medical specialists**: initial, periodic and ongoing for staff from emergency medical care and emergency departments.
