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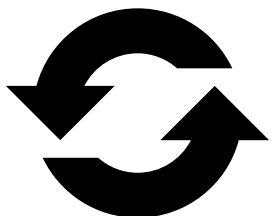
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Health reform

- ❑ Informative report «On Systematically Important Health Care Institutions' Mapping and Development Reform» – emphasis on concentration of highly specialized services
- ❑ Conceptual report «On Health Care System Reform» - comprehensive national planning document incl. the EU funds investments
 - ✓ Local hospitals (incl. ambulatory services) and GPs with emphasis on accessibility
 - ✓ HR accessibility and development
 - ✓ Quality assurance
 - ✓ E-Health

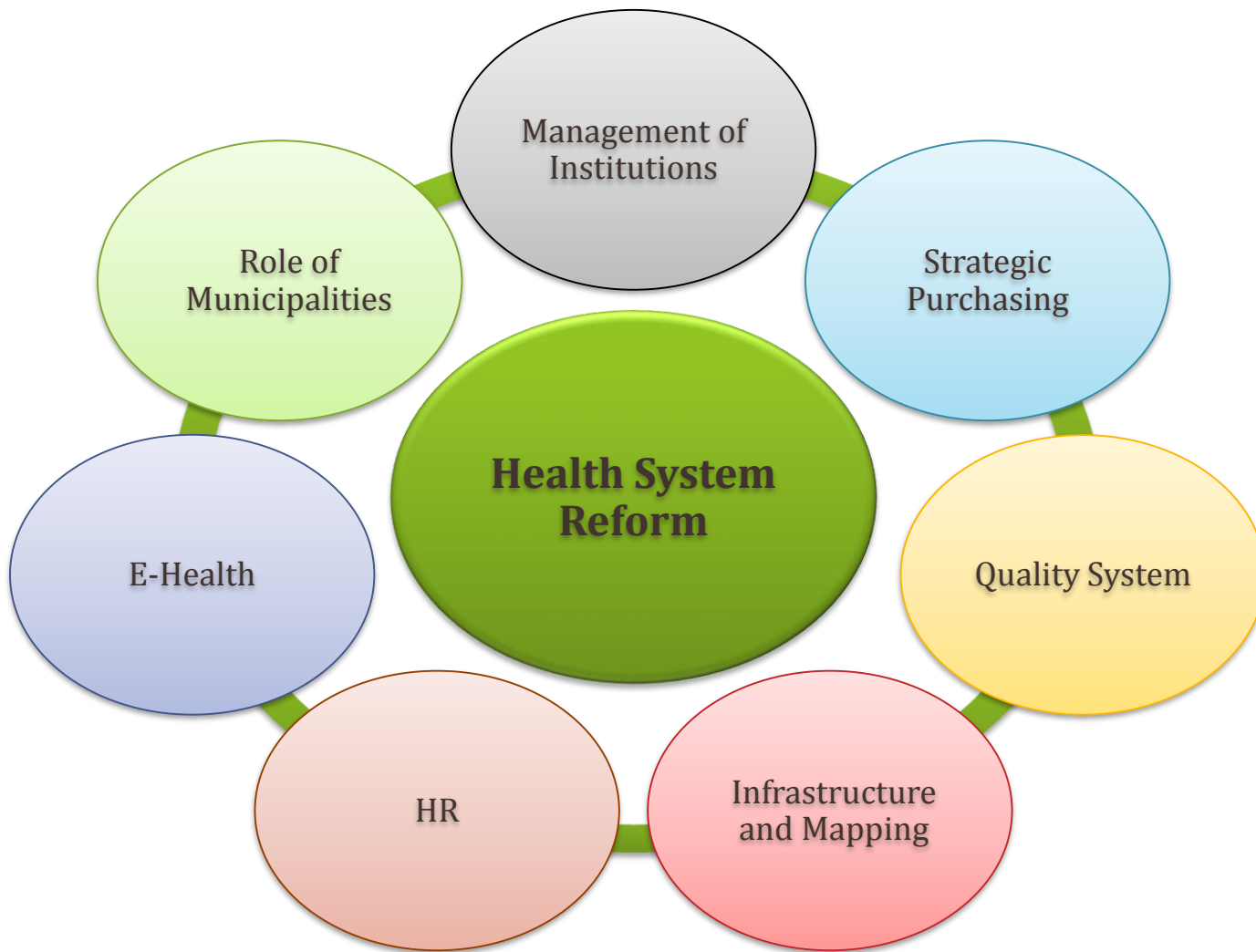

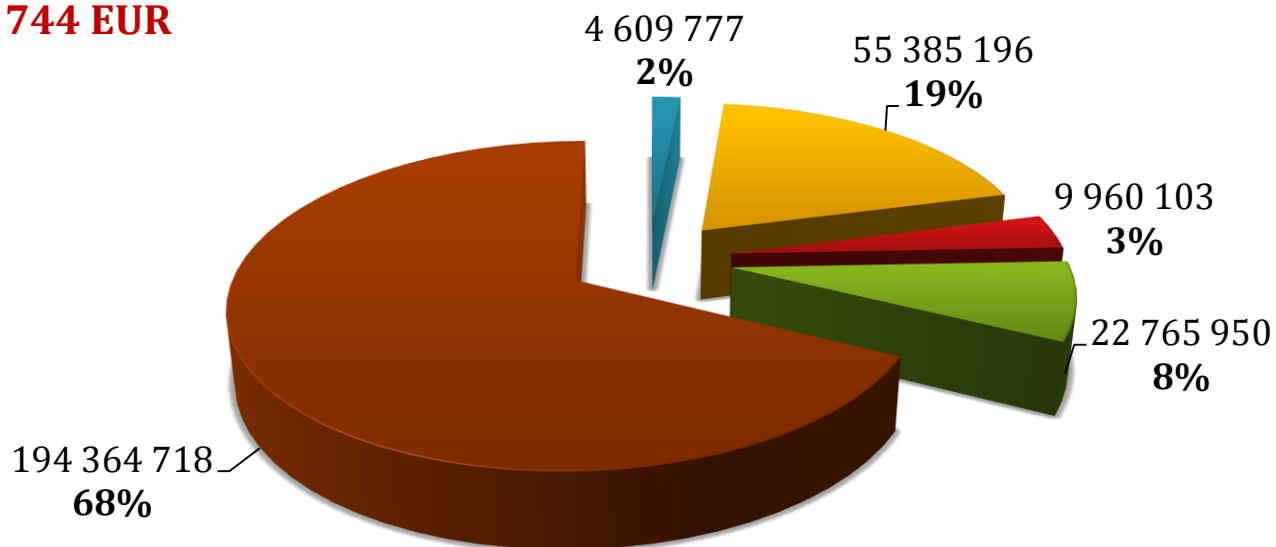


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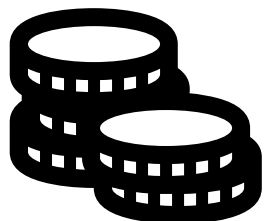
