# Health promotion projects



1. Increase of health literacy
2. Strengthening preventive programs in primary health care and local communities (25 health promotion centers)
3. Mobile units for preventive programs and programs for reducing harm in the field of illicit drugs
4. Integrated early diagnosis and treatment of children with special needs and support to their families, strengthening the competence of professionals
5. Successful integration of the Roma - healthy lifestyle
6. Establishment of an integrated approach to detection and support in abandoning risky and harmful drinking of alcohol among adults in Slovenia

1. A model of long-term care in the community
2. Implementation of pilot projects that will support the transition to the implementation of the system law on long-term care
3. Adaptation and transformation of existing institutional care networks and the entry of new providers to provide community services and programs for the elderly
4. Information support for the implementation of the long-term care system

# Investment projects

1. Construction of an extension in Rehabilitation Center Stara Gora (deinstitutionalization)

Financial value: 2,5 mio EUR

2. Investment in energy efficiency in Slovenian hospitals

Financial value: 1 mio EUR



# Projects in the previous 2007-2013 period of European structural and investment fund



## Implementation of E-health

Main result:

Implementation of modern and interoperable information health system, which enables secure e-commerce and efficient management of profound health and health-related data and information.

**Financial value: 22,1 mio EUR**

## Emergency network centers

Results:

Establishment of modern and rationally organized emergency centers in 10 regional hospitals combining primary and hospital emergency services in one place, thus providing users with faster and more effective medical treatment with significantly improved diagnostic and therapeutic options.

**Financial value: 48,7 mio EUR**
